This means not only simply following the written law, it means conducting our association in conformity with the highest standards of ethics and morality, and avoiding conduct that could give any appearance of wrongdoing.

The following statement is published on our website and read aloud at the beginning of all member committee meetings:

*It is the policy of the Renewable Hydrogen Alliance that the members shall not discuss prices, pricing policies, terms, or conditions of the sale or distribution of products, volume of production, or production quotas, allocation of territories or customers, boycotts of particular firms or products, or any other matter, which might be considered a restraint on competition of any kind.*
